NEW HAVEN, Conn., Feb. 14—Dwight Memorial Chapel of Yale University was the setting this afternoon for the marriage of Miss Sally Thatcher Lane, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. F. Thatcher Lane of New Haven, to Lieut. Chester Alwyn Braman Jr., U. S. N. R., son of Mrs. Hall Braman of Woodmere, N. Y., and Chester A. Braman of Old Chatham, N. Y., and Sarasota, Fla.

The ceremony was performed by the Rev. Sidney Lovett, Yale chaplain. A reception in the home of the bride's parents followed.

Given in marriage by her father, the bride wore a princess gown of ivory satin trimmed with rose-point lace, made with a fitted bodice, long sleeves and a full skirt. Her heirloom veil of rose-point lace draped over tulle was attached to a coronet of the same lace, embellished at the sides with clusters of orange blossoms. She carried a bouquet of miniature white orchids and stephanotis.

Mrs. Donald M. Marshman Jr. of Los Angeles was matron of honor for her sister, and Miss Cynthia Burns of San Francisco and New Haven was maid of honor. The bridesmaids were the Misses Mary L. Braman of Woodmere, sister of the bridegroom; Anita Gurney of Brockton, Mass., and Polly-Anne Maddux of Princeton, N. J.

All the attendants were attired in ballerina-length bouffant gowns of blue chiffon shantung and bandeaux of blue velvet. They carried bouquets of white blossoms combined with lavender.
